Dam - structures built across rivers to control the flow.

Levees - a raised bank of earth built along the edges of rivers to prevent flooding.

Spillways - a structure built into a dam to allow excess water to flow safely.

Beach nourishment - when sand from the ocean or a nearby river is brought in to build up a beach.

Coastal erosion - land lost to the sea.

Terracing - a method of farming on hillsides where the land is divided into flat steps.
